


GOLD COAST AQUATIC CENTRE

Project description

Located on the Gold Coast, Queensland this project was part of a refurbishment of existing pools and provision of new pools for the 2014 Pan Pacific and 2018 Commonwealth Games. The centre includes a 50 metre 10 lane competition pool, program pool, diving pool, learn-to-swim pool and children's play pool. Additional facilities included gymnasium, dry dive facility, spectator concourse and more. The total project cost was in excess of \$41 million.



Pentair products

24 x Starline motor pumps in varying sizes from 50x32-160 to 150x125-315 and motors from 0.75kW to 18.5kW on fixed and variable speed operation. These pumps are of zinc free bronze, cast iron and stainless steel construction with special coatings, wear rings and seal flushing kits.
