



JOHN SAVAGE PROJECT

Project Description

John Savage developer at Savages Wharf, required a pivot to shower his property of 47 hectares. Working with Macquarie Franklin in Launceston, they created a tender design suitable for the type & size of a pivot that John required, in addition to the type of pump needed to pump the water through. Further to acquiring the appropriate pivot, John worked with Ben Osbourne, Manager of Irrigation Tasmania, to install a Valley 11 span centre pivot which met the technical needs from the tender design; powered by a Southern Cross Star-Line 125x100x315 45kW in conjunction with an Onga OJ800K1 as a jacking pump for water transfer.

The pivot irrigates an area of 47 hectares delivering 48.5lps or 4.2 meg over a 24 hour period, and has been running perfectly since installation. Existing crop was pasture and now produces fodder crop (Turnips) for livestock fattening purposes mainly for sheep.

Irrigation Tasmania (Launceston) install approximately 50-60 pivots per year & are the sole distributor for Valley Pivot in Tasmania. These systems were installed in August 2015 and is stage 1 of 2 for this property.
