

TRINITY GRAMMAR AQUATIC CENTRE

Project description

New South Wales' private school Trinity Grammar opened its state-of-the-art swim centre in late 2015. The centre boasts a 8 x 50 metre lanes or 16 x 25 metre lanes pool that features 12 permanently-fixed cameras that can track a swimmer both from an overhead and head-on angle, enabling analysis of the swimmers' starts, turns and free swimming. The years-in-the-making facility cost approximately \$18.2 million.
